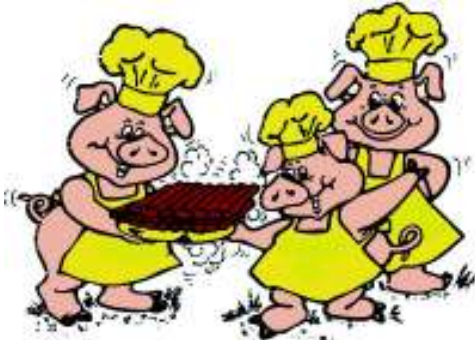

SPEAKERS: Our two Tri-Motor pilots – **Colin Soucy and Ed Rusch** – The History of the Ford Tri-Motor

#### **Colin Soucy**

First flight lesson: 1967 Age 15  
Soloed 1968 on 16th birthday  
First ride in Ford TriMotor October 1963, Port Clinton, OH  
First Flying Job ferrying Pitts Specials for Red Devils  
Aerobatic Flight Team, 1975  
Checked out captain on EAA Ford 4AT September 1989  
Total Ford TriMotor time: 1,100 hours  
Total Ford Landings: 3,000  
Total flight time: 24,600 hours  
Retired airline captain

#### **Ed Rusch**

First Officer on EAA Ford 5AT  
First flight lesson 1962, age 14.  
First Ford ride some time about 1968.  
First flying job 1973, Island Airlines, Port Clinton, Ohio.  
Certified to fly the 4AT at Island Airlines, 1980-1985.  
Barnstormed 4AT for a year, 1986.  
Worked on restoration and did final certifications of 4AT, S/N 10.  
Test flew S/N 10 with John Mohr, first flight of aircraft since 1932.  
Current total Ford time about 650 hrs.  
Current total time about 20,000.
