We'll also hear an update from **Andrey Vegger** about his **Zenith 650 B.**

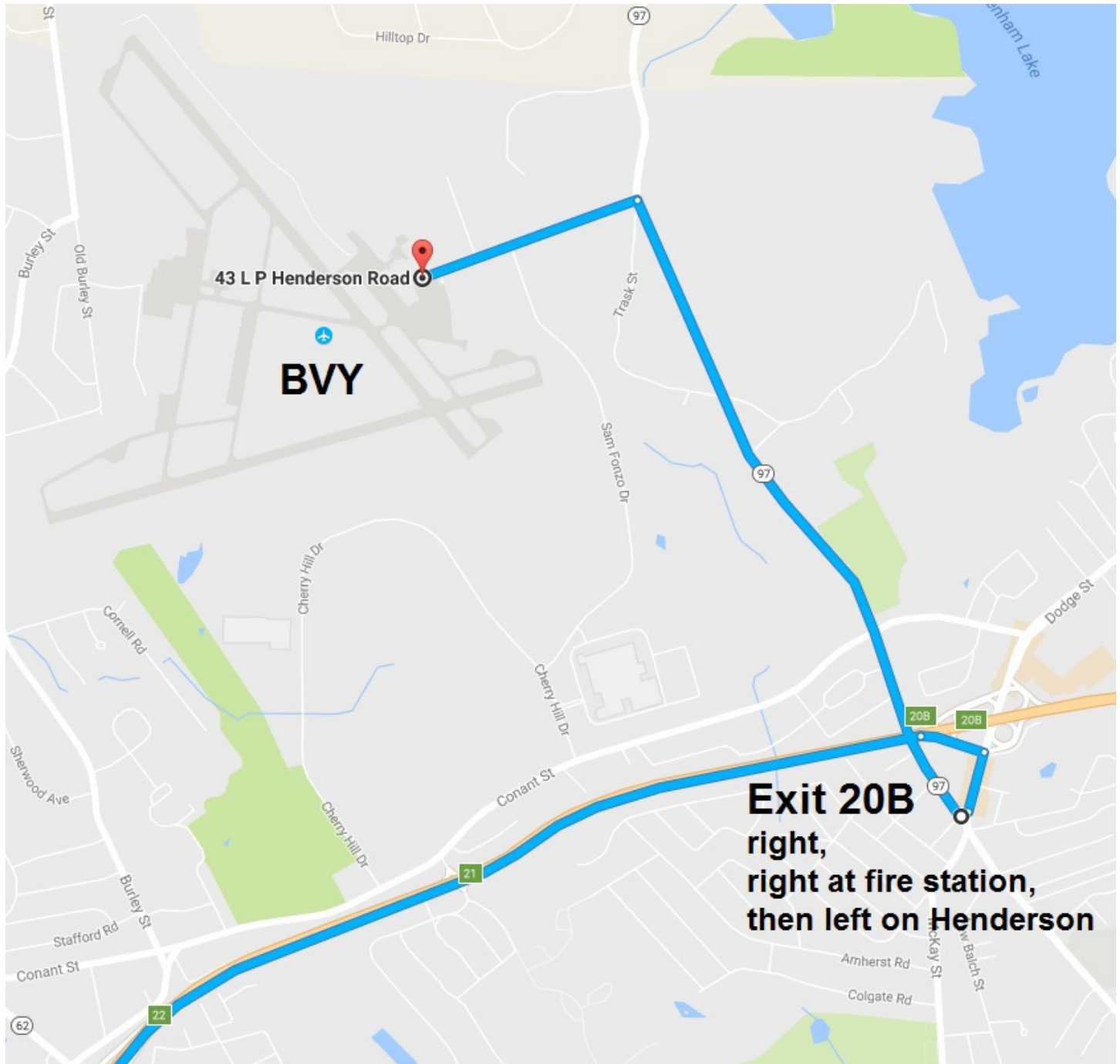
AFTER the meeting: Those interested will get together for lunch nearby (6 minutes away).
