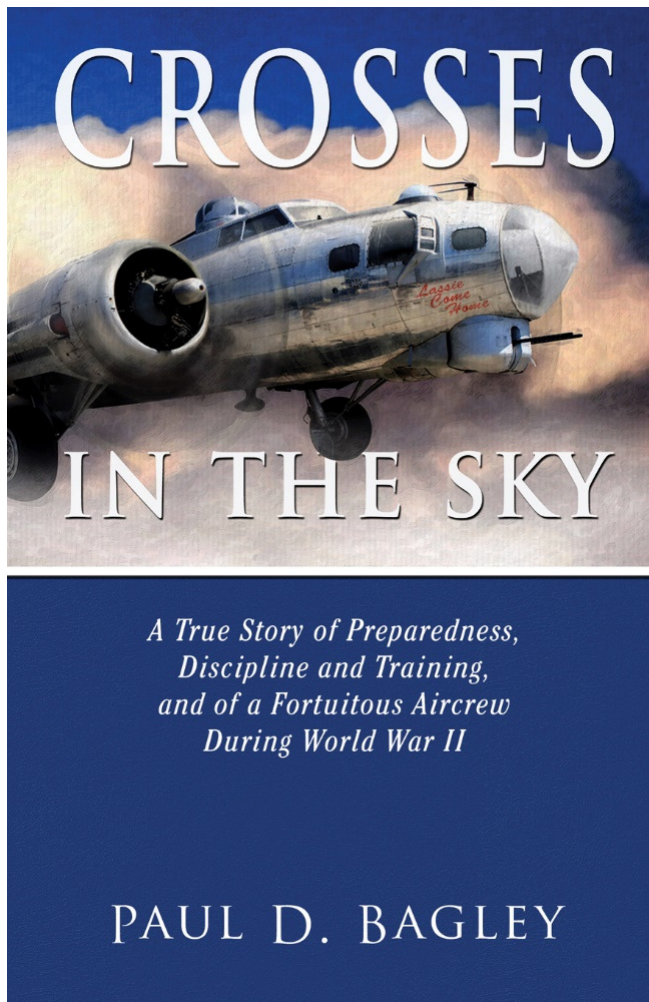


SAT, JUNE 3 – EAA106 PROGRAM – WWII HISTORY – B-17 & its Crew !

Come meet author and historian PAUL D. BAGLEY



Author **Paul D. Bagley** will be our guest speaker presenting a short video production entitled “**Echoes of the Past – Preserving History**” which delves into the history of the famous American **B-17 bomber** and the men who maintained and flew it.

He will also discuss and take questions regarding the 10 years of research he did in preparation of his book **Crosses in the Sky**. The book chronicles one such bomber crew and, in particular, the pilot, Bill Witcomb. Bill and his crew flew 35 missions exclusively over targets in Germany and not one of them was killed, captured or even wounded. They chalked up their good fortune to Devine Providence watching over them, but there was another reason for their extraordinary success. Witcomb and his crew were probably the most well-trained and best prepared weapon ever launched by the US Army Air Force against the Nazi war machine.
